



- **Registration:** The competition is open to participants of all ages and skill levels. There is no registration fee for the competition and any number of entries per registration is allowed.
- **Originality:** All submissions must be original, hand-drawn works created by the participant. Plagiarism or copying from other sources will result in disqualification.
- **Medium:** Participants may use any traditional or digital drawing tools.
- **AI Restriction:** Entries created or enhanced using AI-generated tools will not be accepted.
- **Judging Criteria:** Artwork will be evaluated based on creativity, originality, technique, and adherence to the theme.
- **Verification:** Judges reserve the right to request additional proof to verify authenticity if needed.
- **Submission Format:** Submissions should be sent via Submission link. Digital submissions should be in high-resolution JPEG/PNG format. Traditional artworks should be scanned or photographed clearly.
- **Ethical Considerations:** Entries should be respectful and appropriate for all audiences. Any offensive or inappropriate content will be disqualified.
- **Organizer's Decision:** Winners for the competition in each category will be announced few days after the competition ends. The competition organizers have the final say in determining the eligibility of an artwork.
