Poster Guidelines

- > The overall size of the poster shall be limited to 3' x 4' and the poster should be in portrait.
- > Participants are free to choose the colour scheme that is appropriate to make the poster easy to read and comprehend for your nature of work.
- > Poster Material: Preferably printed on a single sheet of flex or paper.
- ➤ Each poster should have the **Track Number** (T1/T2/T3/T4) **and Track Code** mentioned below the Amrita logo (Arial 100 Pts.) as indicated in the table below:
- The background color of the conference logo and the title can be edited to suit the color scheme of your poster.
- > Ensure that the size of the logo (including aspect ratio) and the location of the track number on the logo are carefully aligned as indicated in this sample.
- The organization, flow and clarity of the information presented (selection of suitable font, font size, layout, etc.) will be considered towards presentation efficacy.
- > Recommended layout: Two-column format, top-left to bottom-right reading order.
- Use sans-serif fonts (e.g., Arial, Helvetica): Title font: ≥ 80 pt, Headings: ≥ 48 pt, Body text: ≥ 36 pt, Figures/Legends: ≥ 24 pt
