Governor C.P.Radhakrishnan at Sadgamaya 2025

The Sadgamaya 2025 Residential Cultural Retreat was inaugurated at Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham by Maharashtra Governor C.P. Radhakrishnan. This three-day event is dedicated to exploring the Indian Knowledge System and brings together faculty and scholars from Amrita for a deep dive into India’s rich philosophical, cultural, and spiritual heritage.

Delivering the keynote address, Governor Radhakrishnan emphasized the lasting relevance of India’s ancient wisdom in shaping modern disciplines such as science, governance, and ethical living.

“Knowledge without spirituality becomes ego; with devotion, it becomes wisdom,” he said, citing the



impact of Amma’s teachings in aligning scientific inquiry with inner transformation.

He further acknowledged India’s historical achievements—such as the invention of zero, advanced metallurgical techniques, and profound ethical

principles—and called for these cultural foundations to be recognized as essential to the nation’s economic and social growth.
