World Quiz Championship to be hosted at Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham on June 7

COIMBATORE, JUN 4:

The World Quiz Championship (WQC) 2025, a premier global knowledge competition, is set to take place in Tamil Nadu on Saturday, June 7 at 3:00 PM, with Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham's Ettimadai campus designated as the official venue.

This event offers quiz enthusiasts from across the state a unique opportunity to represent India on an international platform.

Organized annually by the International Quizzing Association (IQA), London, and coordinated in India by

Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham in collaboration with IQA-Asia, the WQC will be conducted simultaneously across more than 100 locations worldwide. India boasts ten official centers this year, with Coimbatore serving as the exclusive venue for Tamil Nadu.

The competition comprises a three-hour written test featuring 240 questions across eight diverse topics: Science, History, Culture, Current Affairs, Entertainment, Sports, Lifestyle, and Media. It is open to all individuals, regardless of age or educational background.

Participants will receive an official certificate recognizing their representation of India in the World Championship, printed booklet of the 240 quiz questions, an official global ranking based on performance.
