SPORTS FEST YATNA 2025



Leadership and Communication Skills for Nurses in a Multi-Generational Workforce

A workshop on Leadership and Communication Skills for Nurses in a Multi-Generational Workforce was conducted in collaboration with **ANEI** (Association of Nurse Executives of India). There were four interactive sessions, each focusing on critical competencies required for navigating leadership and communication challenges in today's diverse healthcare environment.

The workshop began with an insightful session by Dr. K. T. Moly, Principal, Amrita College of Nursing. She laid a strong foundation with an interesting activity session, which helped the delegates in understanding the characteristics, values, and expectations of different generational cohorts within the nursing workforce. Madam's presentation emphasized the significance of understanding the multi-generational workforce and the challenges each generation group faces in workforce with lots of live examples from her life. Ended the session with a take home message "as we need to remember across generations that there is as much to learn as there is to teach".

The second session was led by Dr. Sunil M, Professor, Amrita College of Nursing. He elaborated on communication barriers and preferences across age groups and provided practical strategies to enhance interpersonal effectiveness.

This third session, conducted by Br. Sai Bala, Nursing Director, AIMS Kochi, was a compelling exploration of leadership approaches suitable for a diverse team. She highlighted the importance of adaptive leadership and how nurse leaders must evolve their style based on the composition of their teams. Her real-world examples and experiences inspired many of the participants to reflect on their leadership practices. The session ended with an interesting group activity to enhance critical thinking to act as a leader in a life situation.

The final session was delivered by Shri. Ajith Menon, from the Institute of Management in Government. He addressed one of the most pertinent challenges in a multi-generational setup—conflict. His session was highly engaging and gave valuable tools for identifying, analyzing, and resolving conflicts constructively.






INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY




