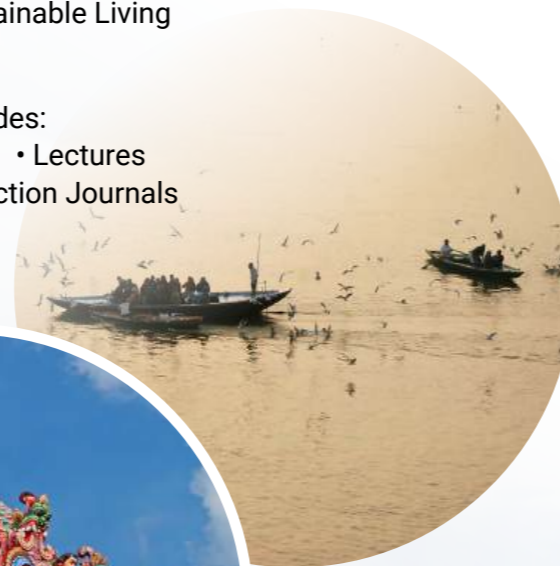
Program Structure
