The School, Hospital and Hostels are extension of MATA AMRITANANDAMAYI MATH, a spiritual and religious organization. Observance of strict discipline is therefore absolutely essential. A pamphlet containing, detailed rules to be strictly observed by the student will be given in person. Special attention is drawn to the following points:

1. Students are required to render due reverence and respect to beloved Amma Chancellor 'Sri Mata Amritanandamayi Devi', founder, guide and inspiration of this institution. Students should also give respect to all monastic Representatives of the Math, all teachers, Professors and senior members of all the Institutions in the Campus.
2. Use of mobile phones and electronic gadgets like iPod, iPad etc. are prohibited in the classroom, unless the teacher requires you to look up anything. If any disturbance is caused in the classroom, the device will be confiscated for minimum one day. The student will be required to make a call to their parent informing them of the confiscation there and then. The student then will hand over the device to the teacher.
3. Ours is strictly 100% residential campus. Students should reside in the hostel. Students are allowed to go home on weekends after taking due permission from Chief warden through warden office. They will NOT return late from weekend outpass.
4. Students should be in their hostel by 09:00 PM. Attendance will be taken at 09:15 PM. If the student is not present at the time of attendance without informing the warden, necessary action will be taken. Students are expected to respect study hours. In the hostel, there should be silence between 09:00 PM and 06:00 AM.
5. There should be absolute silence in the central library at all times.
6. Students are not allowed to keep bikes and cars in the campus (cycles are allowed)
7. Smoking, chewing pan and alcoholic drinks are absolutely prohibited.
8. There is a dress code for all students. Students will wear appropriate decent clothes. Uniform will be worn for classes and other formal functions. They are allowed to wear other clothes on Wednesdays and Saturdays for classes. However such clothing must still be appropriate and decent.
9. Students are not allowed to keep pets in the hostel.

10. Food will be served in the dining areas only. In case the student is not well then the food may be sent to the rooms by permission of the warden. Food will not be cooked in the rooms under any circumstances.
11. Internet is available as a tool for education. It has to be used solely for the purpose of education and any misuse of the net will invite appropriate punishment.
12. Ragging is a criminal offence and is strictly prohibited by NMC Rules and Regulations. If any student is found to have involved or indulged in any incident of ragging the matter will be investigated as NMC Rules. Mere presence at the scene of Ragging amounts to abetment of Ragging and is liable for punishment. Treat your fellow students with respect. In case any student sees any incident of ragging in progress or is aggrieved by any ragging they are required to inform the same on Mob No. 8595903805(Anti Ragging Cell).
13. Students are allowed to go out in groups to see movies, celebrate birthday/marriage etc. However, they have to take prior written permission from the warden to do so. The students should uphold the dignity and tradition of the institute while outside the campus.
