I hereby solemnly and sincerely affirm

1. The statements made and information furnished in my son's/daughter's/ward's application, as well as in all enclosures submitted therewith, are true. Should any information furnished therein be found to be untrue in material particulars, I realize that I shall be liable for criminal prosecution and I agree to the forfeiture of his/her seat in the Institution.
2. My son/daughter/ward shall devote himself/herself fully to studies and shall not indulge in any activity affecting the conducive atmosphere on campus. He/she shall conform strictly to all rules and regulations in force at present or which may be introduced in the Institution hereafter, and I realize that any breach of discipline and rules on the part of my son/daughter/ward shall entail summary forfeiture of his/her seat in the Institution.
3. We are aware that at Amrita, a student is required to attend 100% of classes; however, to accommodate exigencies such as ill health, leave of absence up to 20% in each subject may be permitted, provided leave is applied for with proper certification of the cause of absence and sanctioned by the authorities before or immediately after the absence. Students with less than 80% attendance shall not be permitted to appear for the University examination. Students with less than 60% attendance shall not be permitted to appear for either the University examination or the supplementary examination. They shall be required to complete remedial attendance with the junior batch before becoming eligible to appear for the next University examination. Students with 60% to 75% attendance shall be permitted to appear for the regular University examination after completing the prescribed attendance requirement through remedial classes.
4. We are aware that the curriculum for the course is not rigid and that my son/daughter/ward shall follow the syllabus for the course in force at the time of his/her admission, and that any revision or modification made in the syllabus during the course of study in the Institution shall be binding on him/her. We are also aware that my son/daughter/ward shall undergo one hour of weekly training under the IAM (Integrated Amrita Meditation) programme.
5. We are aware that if my son/daughter/ward does not secure a minimum of 50% marks in the day-to-day evaluation of his/her work and progress, he/she shall not be permitted to appear for the University examination.
6. In case my son's/daughter's/ward's progress in studies is uniformly poor in the Institution, his/her studies are liable to be terminated as per NMC norms.
7. In the event of discontinuation of studies during the course or removal from the rolls of the School for any reason, he/she shall be liable to pay fees for the remaining years of study.
8. My son/daughter/ward is aware that breach of discipline and rules or misconduct in extracurricular activities shall also entail summary forfeiture of seat in the Institution, in addition to such other proceedings as may be taken against him/her.

9. I am aware that if my son/daughter/ward is admitted to the hostel, he/she shall strictly abide by the rules and regulations in force in the hostels, and that any breach of discipline or rules, or any unruly conduct or undesirable activity, shall be dealt with summarily by expulsion from the hostel and the Institute, in addition to such other proceedings as may be taken against him/her.

10. We understand that ragging is a criminal offence and is strictly prohibited by law. Any student found to be involved in, indulging in, or abetting any incident of ragging shall be summarily expelled from the Institution and the matter shall also be reported to the Police for initiating necessary legal action. All losses incurred by the Institution on account of such action shall be made good by the student. We also understand that mere presence at the scene of ragging shall amount to abetment of ragging. The decision of the Principal with regard to expulsion, loss and recoveries shall be final and binding. Separate undertakings relating to anti-ragging are also furnished.
